A request to the parents of boarders at Columba College from the Columba College House Doctor, Dr M.J. Copland.

We request medical records of all boarding students at Columba College including their immunisation records.

ALL parents are to indicate their permission for the influenza vaccination, to be given in Term Two 2016.

Please complete the form even though you may have filled in a similar form in previous years. There may be new information, which is critical to the health of your daughter.

A Health Profile will enable us to know your daughter better and give her optimum medical care.

The computer files are updated each year so that when your daughter leaves Columba College this information can be sent back to your family doctor on request. We would greatly appreciate either you or your family doctor completing the attached form.

Consultation at Roslyn Medical Centre	\$22.00
Consultation at the Roslyn Medical Centre with a Nurse	\$8.00 - \$15.00
Consultation at the Roslyn Medical Centre for an International Student <u>without</u> Government funding	\$70.00
Full Immigration Medical Fee	\$200.00
International students are required to pay at the time of consultation.	

A monthly account will be sent to parents for services rendered which includes a small accounting fee. Please advise us of any existing Community Service Cards or High User Health Cards that apply to your daughters.

New Zealand students turning 18 during the year will need a Community Services Card of their own. They need to apply at least one month before their 18th birthday in order for us to claim a subsidy. Those without a card will have to be charged an adult price of \$35.00. If you have a Community Services Card the charge will be \$22.00.
