NOTICE FOR PARENTS AND STUDENTS

CALEDONIAN GROUND, DUNEDIN

Reporting time: All girls are required at the Caledonian Ground by 8.30am for roll call which will be in front of the main stand. The Sports are scheduled to start sharp at 9.00am and are expected to conclude at 3.00pm. Girls are to report direct to the Caledonian and may go home direct from there at the conclusion of the Sports.

TRANSPORT TO CALEDONIAN GROUND

Day Girls: Parents are to make arrangements to transport their daughters to the Caledonian Ground by 8.30am. Please note – due to construction work access to the Caledonian will be from Butts Road.

Boarding House Girls: Buses have been arranged to take all the boarders to the Caledonian Ground, leaving at 8.05am and are also booked to return the boarders to Columba College, leaving the Caledonian Ground around 3.00pm.

HOSPITALITY AVAILABLE

Tea and coffee and light snacks for parents, family members and staff will be available in the hospitality room courtesy of the Sports Council. Parents planning to spend the day at the Caledonian are advised to bring snacks/food.

LUNCH

The girls are to bring lunch and a drink, and some snacks. A sausage sizzle will be selling \$2 sausages and water (cash only).

UNIFORM

All girls are required to wear their regulation Columba College tracksuit to and from the Caledonian Ground. They will also need (these garments can be worn under the tracksuit or carried to the Caledonian in their sports bags/backpacks):

- Navy blue Canterbury shorts or shorts in their House colour (essential for track events)
- Navy blue sports shirt or a T-shirt/top in their House colour
- Columba College rugby jersey, hoody or merino top (for extra warmth)
- Gym shoes
- If the day is cool, a rug can be an idea for the girls between events. Columba College blankets are for sale in the boarding house.
