



Year 9 – 11 Exchange Opportunities

You will live in a world that is connected through travel, trade, tourism, service and relationships. To prepare for this world we welcome visitors from all over the globe and provide opportunities for you to travel to interesting places in a safe and supported way. Language and cultural immersion leads to tolerance, understanding, friendship, peace, self-development and open-mindedness.

These reciprocal exchanges allow you to attend a sister school, stay in the home of a host sister, and experience the sights and sounds of the region. In turn you host your exchange partner in your home and class, and plan fun things to do in Dunedin and surrounds.

Boarders: We support you in participating in exchanges, and endeavor to provide accommodation for your host sister although you may expect a change of rooms or arrangements while hosting. You must plan to take your exchange student home for weekends, and make arrangements for after school activities in Dunedin. If your exchange host is in the boarding house for longer than 10 days, or your exchange is in the Christmas holidays, there will be a small charge to cover expenses of an extra person in the boarding house.

For international exchanges there is a non refundable \$50 per person administration fee in addition to the direct costs of the exchange.

Applications for exchanges are to be in to the office by Friday 24th February EXCEPT Japan – please apply by 14th February.
